
Naracoorte Neighbour Day 2023 A fantastic team effort!

Aaron's Hungarian Goulash







Prep: 25 minutes

Cook: 2-3 hours

Serves: 4 - 6

Ingredients

- 700g stewing steak
- 2 chorizo sausages chopped roughly
- 1 large onion
- 1 red capsicum
- 1 green capsicum
- 2 Tbsp sweet paprika
- 300ml beef stock
- 4 potatoes (cut chunky but can cut how you prefer)
- 2 tomatoes diced
- 150ml sour cream (for serving)
- salt and pepper

The longer it is cooked, the better. This

The longer it is cooked, the better. This meal could also be done in a slow cooker – just pop all ingredients in together.

Cooking steps

- 1. Roughly chop and braise steak (braise steak separately).
- **2.** Braise onion, capsicum and chorizo, add paprika and salt and pepper.
- **3.** Put all ingredients in a pot with the stock and tomatoes.
- **4.** Bring to the boil then reduce to a simmer with lid ajar.
- 5. Slow cook for 2 to 3 hours.
- **6.** Dish is ready when all veggies are soft and tender with a fork.



Living by the code, "The only limitations are the limitations you put on yourself," she is the first person in her family to attend and graduate from university – something her family is enormously proud of.



Some of her other interests include photography, supporting the Essendon Bombers, connecting with friends and family, and going to the beach when the weather is nice.

Her future plans include the possibility of further study and working on a documentary film of her own.


